Background

Following the 2024 park tours, staff compiled the maintenance items noted during the tours onto a spreadsheet to allow for simplified tracking. Throughout the year, the Public Works team has worked to continue to cross items off the list. They have also provided notes about how often some practices are performed as part of their routine maintenance schedule.

The Park Commission has decided to forego park tours this year with the ongoing master planning process. In lieu of the tours, Commissioners plan to do self-guided tours as they are able to through the City parks. Commissioners should check on completed items, note any new items found, and provide those notes to staff so the spreadsheet can be updated. Staff will provide an updated copy with the new maintenance items at the August Park Commission meeting.

Background

The Park Commission typically discusses the Parks Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) during the July meeting. The CIP is a 10-year plan for larger scale projects, typically costing \$5,000 or more, that assists in the strategic planning of our parks system. In 2025, the City had budgeted \$40,000 to conduct a Parks Master Plan which is currently underway and projected to complete in December of 2025. There was also \$200,000 allocated towards the Cathcart Park Playground in 2025. However, with the ongoing master planning process this project has been put on pause.

The master plan that is in development will assist the Commission and staff in prioritizing capital expenditures based on community wants and needs, along with local, regional, and national trends in Parks & Recreation. The 2026 budgeting process is well underway, and staff is working with the finance department on how to properly provide CIP recommendations to the City Council. With the consultant for the Parks Master Plan in attendance for the meeting, staff is requesting the Commission discuss current projects to provide valuable background information for the consultant.

Action Requested

Discussion of the upcoming projects currently included in the CIP, along with potential projects to add.
