



City of Shorewood BIRCH BLUFF STREET AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The City of Shorewood is proposing to complete a full street and utility reconstruction project for Birch Bluff Road. This project is part of the city's Capital Improvement Program (CIP), with construction slated for summer of 2023. At this time, staff is reviewing existing pavement, wetlands, topography, trees, right-of-way, drainage, condition of the sanitary sewer, and the condition of the lift station. WHAT TO EXPECT

Throughout the summer residents will see Bolton & Menk personnel reviewing wetlands, trees, drainage, and topography. Bolton & Menk staff and possibly other sub consultants will take soil borings, review the existing sanitary sewer system, and review the existing lift station. The information that is gathered will allow the city to develop solutions to address the project concerns and review impacts to residents. If you have concerns or issues unique to your property, please contact the city to discuss.
