- Improve pavement condition (2025 construction)
- Address known safety concerns:
 - Speeding, pedestrians, sightlines, on street parking
- Discuss desire/need for sidewalk from 2011 Trail Master Plan
- Address existing utility items (watermain & sanitary sewer)
- Improve drainage











Pedestrian Overview: Strava Walk/Run Heat Map






Pedestrian Overview: Strava Cycling Heat Map










- Potential new curb - green




- Coordinate with HCRRA and TRPD on potential Lake Minnetonka Regional Trail crossing improvements




Example-Reconstruction













Project Summary

Scoping Summary of Costs & Duration

- Option 1: Reclamation and add sidewalk on East side
 - \$1.77 - \$1.96 Million**
 - Roadway expected to last 20-30 years
 - Construction duration = 10-16 weeks
- Option 2: Mill & Overlay
 - \$325,000 - \$660,000**
 - Typical roadway expected to last 10-15 years
 - Construction duration = 4-7 weeks
- Option 3: Reclamation and addition of curb
 - \$1.11- \$1.46 Million**
 - Roadway expected to last 20-30 years
 - Construction duration = 6-10 weeks

**Range of costs account for unknowns of utility repairs, extent of curb, and full depth street repairs.



Next Steps:

- Council Provide Direction on Scope
 - Likely January 2024 Council Meeting
- Complete Final Design
 - Late-Summer/Winter 2024
- Bidding Process
 - Spring 2025
- Construction
 - Summer 2025
